Isaiah 6:1-9a

In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the LORD seated on a throne, high and exalted, and the train of His robe filled the temple. Above Him were seraphs, each with six wings: With two wings they covered their faces, with two they covered their feet, and with two they were flying. And they were calling to one another:

*“Holy, holy, holy is the LORD Almighty;
The whole earth is full of His glory.”*

At the sound of their voices the doorposts and thresholds shook and the temple was filled with smoke.

“Woe to me!” I cried. *“I am ruined! For I am a man of unclean lips, and I live among a people of unclean lips, and my eyes have seen the King, the LORD Almighty.”*

Then one of the seraphs flew to me with a live coal in his hand, which he had taken with tongs from the altar. With it he touched my mouth and said, *“See, this has touched your lips; your guilt is taken away and your sin atoned for.”*

Then I heard the voice of the LORD saying, *“Whom shall I send and who will go for us?”*

And I said, *“Here am I. Send me!”*
